27TH BARRAMUNDI CLASSIC – TOURNAMENT DAY 1

Third place is Club Marine Scurvy Dogs, just twenty points further back, with skipper Wayne Baldwin's catch of the day keeping crew members Chris Errity and Andrew "ET" Etingshausen in contention.
