27TH BARRAMUNDI CLASSIC – TOURNAMENT DAY 2

Day two was an even better day than yesterday with 346 barra caught, bringing the Classic total so far to 661, compared to 454 caught at this stage at last year's tournament. Catch of the day was the first 1 metre-plus fish caught, at 1.03 metres by Ross McCubbin from team Lucky Strike. The Champion Angler for the day was Daly River extraordinaire, Col Cordingley from Scorpion Stingers, who is fishing in his 26th Barra Classic. Col amassed a total of 915 points.

Leading team after Day 2 is Scorpion Stingers on 2015 points, helped along nicely by skipper Col Cordingley's big haul. Teammates Neil Patrick and Lindsay Dobe also contributed and both sit in the top 20 anglers.

Yesterday's leaders, Team Woodstock are in second position, 195 points behind and Michael Dickinson, Peter O'Sullivan and Burke Staples will be striving to regain the lead on Day 3. The visiting team from WA, Pilbarians are a further 70 points behind in third position, comprising Mark Cottrell, Ben Robinson and Justin Neil.

Champion lady angler for the day was Tanya Urvet from Sister Act.
